

Oral Oncology Copay Reduction Program for Commercially Insured Members

Florida Blue and Truli for Health members may now qualify for a new Oral Oncology Copay Reduction program. It offers reduced copays on drugs prescribed for the treatment of cancer for drugs having uses in both oncology and non-oncology disease states.

A list of eligible medications is included in the table below. As an example, methotrexate tablets would qualify for a copay reduction when a completed CoverMyMeds [form](#) confirms the drug is being used to treat a cancer type recognized by the FDA-label or NCCN Drugs and Biologics Compendium as a category 1 or 2A recommendation (e.g., acute lymphoblastic leukemia).
