Interoperability Readiness Underway for 2027 Implementation

Florida Blue is working to enable Application Programming Interfaces (API) by January 1, 2027, in support of the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS) interoperability requirements under CMS-0057-F. Pharmacy Updates to Commercially Insured Medical Coverage Guidelines Now Available

Our Medical Coverage Guidelines (MCG) for the commercially insured are published monthly and quarterly at FloridaBlue.com under *Medical and Pharmacy Policies and Guidelines, What's New*. The September 15, 2026 updates feature a change to the Familial Chylomicronemia Syndrome and Severe Hypertriglyceridemia MCG updating the Tryngolza covered indications to include adults at risk of pancreatitis with severe hypertriglyceridemia. The Tzield MCG was revised to expand use for pediatric patients with Stage 3 type 1 diabetes. Many other MCG changes are listed. [Learn more>>](#)

Fee Schedule Change for Certain Drugs on the Physician-Administered Drug Program

We are updating reimbursement for some drug codes on our Physician-Administered Drug Program managed by Prime Therapeutics Management Medical Pharmacy Solutions, effective October 1, 2026. This applies to all Florida Blue commercial and Truli for Health plans. There is no change to the process for requesting a preservice medical necessity review for these drugs.

CMS is conducting a contract-level risk adjustment data validation audit for Medicare Advantage plans. This includes BlueMedicare HMO and PPO members with 2023 dates of service for payment year 2024.
