#### **CMS Conducts Risk Adjustment Data Validation Audit for Medicare Advantage Members**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is conducting a routine risk adjustment data validation audit for Medicare Advantage plans. This includes our BlueMedicare HMO and PPO members with 2020 dates of service. Between June and November 2026, your practice may receive requests for medical records to help CMS verify the accuracy of diagnosis data used for Medicare Advantage payments. Effective July 1, 2026, Florida Blue will expand Site of Care guidelines for select oncology and non-oncology provider-administered medications.
