

Limited Distribution and Specialty Pharmacy Network Updates Effective April 1, 2025

We are sharing the latest updates to our Limited Distribution Drugs (LDD) medication list, effective April 1, 2025. LDDs are specialty medications only available through a small number of pharmacies, which are determined by the product manufacturer.

There are many LDDs available through our in-network specialty pharmacies. If participating specialty pharmacies are unable to dispense these drugs, Florida Blue members with commercial and Truli for Health plans can obtain them through our LDD network.
