



Commercial Specialty Pharmacy Network Changes Coming January 2026

We are expanding our specialty network with the Advocate+™ Pharmacy Match program through Free Market Health (FMH) to better serve our members and help lower their costs. Beginning on **January 1, 2026**, there will be changes to how you send specialty pharmacy prescriptions for Florida Blue and Truli for Health members with commercial plans.

The Advocate+ Pharmacy Match program includes a wider network of pharmacies for specialty prescriptions. Through an automated system, this program determines the best in-network specialty pharmacy to fill a member's specialty medication based on access, quality, and cost.

How it Works and Where to Send Specialty Prescriptions Starting January 1

All <u>Self-Administered</u> specialty medication prescriptions should be sent directly to the FMH pharmacy via the contact information below starting January 1. FMH will use Advocate+ Pharmacy Match to forward the prescription to the matched specialty pharmacy.

It is important to note, CVS Specialty[®] will continue to be our medical pharmacy provider. Please send orders for <u>Provider-Administered drugs</u> directly to CVS Specialty pharmacy. You can continue to buy and bill medications if you prefer.

Long-acting injectable (LAI) antipsychotics, substance use disorder, and behavioral health medications will continue to be dispensed and administered by <u>Genoa Healthcare</u>. Prior authorization reviews for these medications should continue to be sent to Prime Therapeutics via <u>CoverMyMeds</u>. Those prescriptions should be sent directly to Genoa Healthcare.

Special Circumstances

There are certain scenarios when prescriptions should be directly routed through the Advocate+ Pharmacy Match program and do not need to be sent directly to these entities. Specifically:

- Hemophilia medication will continue to be dispensed by CVS Specialty, with prior authorization requests sent through Availity Essentials.
- Limited Distribution pharmacies will continue to be contracted and listed on the <u>Limited</u>
 <u>Distribution web page</u>.

Free Market Health, Genoa Healthcare, Prime Therapeutics, and CVS Specialty are independent companies that provide pharmacy services on behalf of Florida Blue.

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Prior Authorization Changes

To streamline this change to Advocate+ Pharmacy Match, we are also making updates to where prior authorization requests are sent.

Effective January 1, prior authorizations will no longer be reviewed by CVS Specialty. Self-administered prior authorization requests will be reviewed by Prime Therapeutics and should be sent via CoverMyMeds.

Provider-administered prior authorization requests can be submitted via <u>Availity Essentials</u>TM or to <u>Prime Medical</u> for drugs included in the <u>Provider-Administered Drug Program (PADP)</u>.

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
