

## **Improving Quality of Care for Substance Use Disorder**

Understanding key Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®1) measures is important to ensuring successful health outcomes for your patients. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) works with the National Committee for Quality Assurance to collect HEDIS-related data. The **Initiation and Engagement of Substance Use Disorder Treatment** (IET) measure is one of the key measures used by CMS. This measure is used specifically to determine episodes that result in treatment initiation and engagement.

Diagnosis of substance use disorders can be related to alcohol, opioids, or other substances. ## **Leveraging the GuideWell Provider Portal Tools**

The Provider Portal provides valuable insights regarding our members' health care journey. This information can help you track your patients' care related to substance use disorder in support of several HEDIS measures. This data is refreshed daily, giving you near real-time information on hospital or emergency room visits for your patients.

Within the portal's Practice Summary Dashboard, you have access to data related to member demographics, coding and quality opportunities, pharmacy, and behavioral health. You can also use the *Census* tool to sort behavioral health related admissions within your patient population. The "BH" column in the *Census* report helps identify patients with substance use disorder.
