Important Details About 2025 Medicare Star Measures: Poly-ACH and COB

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services introduced two new Part D Star measures for the 2025 measurement year. These measures – Polypharmacy: Use of Multiple Anticholinergic Medications in Older Adults (Poly-ACH) and Concurrent Use of Opioids and Benzodiazepines (COB) – aim to improve the quality of care for Medicare Advantage patients by reducing risks associated with certain medication combinations. <u>Learn more>></u>
