- ✓ **Get informed.** The Marketplace is changing. Here's a highlight of the changes to be aware of:
  - The government is ending extra financial help in 2025, increasing costs
  - Extra steps are now required to receive financial help
  - Less time to fix issues with your enrollment information to keep your subsidy
  - Fewer chances to enroll outside of Open Enrollment Period
- ✓ **Assess your coverage needs.** Review the health services used in the past year. Consider any special needs or medical conditions. Think about recent changes, such as new family members, surgeries, medical conditions, or a new location.
- ✓ **Identify must-haves.** Do you have certain prescriptions you need? Are there doctors, hospitals, or services you prefer? Make a list of everything you know you need and want to make choosing a health plan easier.
- ✓ **Gather family details.** Have the names, mailing and home addresses, and Social Security numbers of everyone you will cover in your plan.
- ✓ **Gather documentation.** You will need to have your 2024 tax return and IRS Form 8962 to reconcile your tax credit. You'll also now need proof of household income. Other documents may also be required for your circumstances.
