Federal Employee Program

Pregnancy Care Incentive Program

The Blue Cross and Blue Shield Federal Employee Program® (FEP) offers a pregnancy care program with benefits and incentives designed to support expectant members from the prenatal through postpartum stages of their pregnancies. It is available at no additional cost to eligible FEP members.

Program Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for this care incentive program, the member must be:

- Currently enrolled in FEP Blue Standard™ or FEP Blue Basic™
- A minimum of 18 years old
- Earning an incentive for no more than two pregnancies within the year
- Meet timeline requirements:
 - Members who give birth in 2025 who have a documented first trimester prenatal visit in 2024 or 2025 related to the birth of a child in 2025
 - Members with a 2026 due date who prove they had a first trimester prenatal visit in 2025

Program Benefits and Validation

When an FEP patient meets eligibility, they can request a **Pregnancy Care Box**. The care box includes useful products and educational materials to support them during pregnancy. The box also contains a **cover sheet** for the patient and their doctor to complete to validate the first trimester checkup and access the additional rewards outlined below. Following the patient's first trimester checkup, they may **earn \$75** on their MyBlue[®] Wellness card. Patients may also receive an **additional \$50** after completing the Blue Health Assessment found in their MyBlue member account.
