Important Reminders About Patient Data Requests

All requests for member information must comply with requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). This includes submitting Health Care Eligibility and Benefits (270) and Claim Status (276) inquiry transactions only when necessary. Please review and follow these guidelines to ensure compliance with this HIPAA mandate. *Learn more>>*

The latest changes to our pharmacy programs become effective January 1, 2026. These changes affect our preferred drug lists and medication guides, including prior authorization requirements, the Responsible Quantity Program, Responsible Steps, and the Pharmacy Coverage Exclusions List. <u>Learn more></u>

Pharmacy Updates to Commercially Insured Medical Coverage Guidelines Now Available Each month and quarter, our Medical Coverage Guidelines (MCG) for the commercially insured are updated and published at FloridaBlue.com under *Medical and Pharmacy Policies and Guidelines, What's*New. The December 15, 2025 updates include, but are not limited to, a revision to the Rituxumab products MCG to add Truxima as co-preferred with Ruxience and Riabni.
