



## Update: Genoa Pharmacy Now In-Network for Dispensing and *Administering*Long-Acting Antipsychotic Injectable Drugs

As announced earlier this year, Genoa Healthcare® (Genoa) Pharmacy, a provider of long-acting injectable (LAI) antipsychotic and substance use disorder drugs and services, is in-network for dispensing LAI drugs under Florida Blue and Truli for Health (Truli) pharmacy benefits. Now, Genoa is also in-network for both dispensing and *administering* LAI antipsychotic and substance use disorder drugs in Florida in-state locations. The locations may be found at the Genoa website included below.

As a reminder, on July 1, 2024, Florida Blue and Truli expanded LAI drug access for antipsychotic and substance use disorder services for commercial members with pharmacy benefits. Florida Blue and Truli in-network plans with pharmacy benefits include the following BIN/PCN combinations:
