

Osteoporosis Screening in Older Women (OSW)

By working together, we can improve health outcomes for your patients, our members. The Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) helps us measure many aspects of performance. This tip sheet provides key details of the HEDIS measure for osteoporosis screening in older women (OSW).

What Is the Measure?

The percentage of women ages 65-75 years who received osteoporosis screening

Exclusions

- Persons who use hospice services or elect to use a hospice benefit any time during the measurement year.
- Persons who die any time during the measurement year.
- Persons receiving palliative care any time during the measurement year.
- Persons who had an encounter for palliative care any time during the measurement year. Do not include laboratory claims.
- Persons ages 66 years and older as of December 31 of the measurement year (all product lines) with frailty **and** advanced illness. Persons must meet **both** frailty and advanced illness criteria to be excluded:
 1. **Frailty.** At least two indications of frailty with different dates of service during the measurement year.
 2. **Advanced Illness.** Any of the following during the measurement year or the year prior to the measurement year:
 - Advanced illness on at least two different dates of service
 - Dispensed dementia medication

What Meets the Measure Requirements?

One or more osteoporosis screening tests on or between the person's 65th birthday and December 31 of the measurement year.

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
