Code Updates for Medicare Advantage Cardiovascular Services, Oncology and Hematology, and Radiation Oncology Prior Authorization Programs

HCPCS/CPT codes for our Medicare Advantage prior authorization programs offered through Evolent have been updated, effective August 25, 2025. The updates apply to cardiovascular services, oncology and hematology, and radiation oncology. Codes included in a claim must be the same as the approved codes to avoid claim disruptions or denials. <u>Learn more>></u>
