

## Adults' Access to Preventative/Ambulatory Health Services (AAP)

By working together, we can improve health outcomes for your patients, our members. The Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) helps us measure many aspects of performance. This tip sheet provides key details of the HEDIS measure for Adults' Access to Preventative/Ambulatory Health Services (AAP).

### What Is the Measure?

The measure focuses on members age 20 and older who had an ambulatory or preventive care visit during the measurement year (Medicare) or during the measurement year or two years prior (commercial). To assess compliance for this measure properly, a commercial member must be continuously enrolled with Florida Blue for the last three years.

### How to Improve Your Quality Score

- Schedule preventive care appointments for your patients and report the appropriate code to Florida Blue.
- Report the appropriate codes for adult patients with one or more ambulatory or preventive care visits during the measurement year or the two years before.

Measure updates will not be reflected in gap closures until the measure requirements are updated in the fall.
