Make sure to read your loved one's Annual Notice of Changes (ANOC) letter. It should arrive in your mail by September 30.

Help your loved one evaluate their Medicare plan using their ANOC letter. Is their Medicare plan is still meeting their needs?

If it's time to pick a new plan, the Annual Enrollment Period is October 15-December 7. If your loved one moves or has been impacted by a hurricane or disaster, they may qualify for a Special Enrollment Period. Talk to your loved one's agent.
