MYTH

I can't afford health insurance



FACT

More than 1 in 3 customers in Florida selected a plan for \$10 per month or less after subsidies in 2023.¹ And now, if you get your health coverage through your job, your family members may qualify for a Marketplace plan with financial assistance.

MYTH

I earn too much to get financial assistance



FACT

An additional 460,000 uninsured in Florida can now get financial help. Recent changes to the Affordable Care Act mean you'll pay no more than 8.39% of your family income—and it could be even less.²

Finding a plan is too confusing



FACT
