Important Reminder: Keep Your Profile Current to Stay Listed in Our Provider Directories

Federal law requires all providers, health care facilities, and suppliers to regularly verify and update their profile information with payers – even if their information has not changed. If your information is not updated timely, it will be removed from our directories, as required by law. BILLING AND CODING

Update: Service Facility ID Required for Professional Claims

All Florida Blue providers (and non-participating providers) are required to include the Service Facility National Provider Identifier or the Florida Blue Service Facility ID on professional claims billed in a facility setting. This applies to all hospital and facility professional claims for Florida Blue and Truli for Health (Truli) lines of business, except for Medicare crossover and Medicaid. [Learn more>>](#)

Pharmacy Updates to Commercially Insured Medical Coverage Guidelines Now Available

Each month and quarter, our Medical Coverage Guidelines (MCG) for the commercially insured are updated and published at FloridaBlue.com under *Medical and Pharmacy Policies and Guidelines, What's New*. The January 15, 2026 updates include, but are not limited to, a revision to the **Hereditary Angioedema (HAE) Drug Therapy** MCG to include preferred products for prophylaxis of HAE attacks (Andembry, Haegarda, and Orladeyo) and generic icatibant preferred for the treatment of an acute HAE attack. This change also includes a revision to the **Ravicti** MCG to require use of generic glycerol phenylbutyrate. Many other MCG updates are listed. [Learn more>>](#)
