

Authorization Process Change for Sleep Study Program

Florida Blue is introducing a change to the authorization process for our Sleep Study program. This change aims to streamline the authorization process and simplify workflows. Effective **December 29, 2025**, Florida Blue will move the management of Sleep Study authorizations for all Commercial and Medicare Advantage members from CareCentrix to Availity^{®1} AuthAI, a health care automation platform. Please note, this change impacts Sleep Study program procedures only.

AuthAl Technology - AuthAl uses artificial intelligence to review clinical forms and
documents, providing immediate approvals when possible. Its technology allows for
faster, more efficient processing of pre-service review requests. Any requests that pend
for medical review will be completed by the Florida Blue Clinical Team. You can find

What Remains the Same

- Claims processing for Sleep Study program procedures
- Authorization process for other CareCentrix programs such as Home Health, Home Infusion, and Durable Medical Equipment

Note: Authorizations requested with errors are not eligible for provider appeal. Authorization errors include, but are not limited to, incorrect treating provider, place of service, or date of service, as well as failure to obtain prior authorization.

New Process

- Starting on December 29, 2025, you must log into Availity and access AuthAl (under Applications in the Florida Blue Payer Space) to:
 - o request prior authorization reviews
 - o submit or check the status of an authorization request
