Here we are highlighting some important HEDIS quality measures for you and your staff. These standards help us measure many aspects of the physician and accountable care organization performance and promote improved health outcomes for our members, your patients.

HEDIS Measure	Inclusion Criteria	Exclusions
Avoidance of Antibiotic Treatment for Acute Bronchitis/Bronchiolitis (AAB)	 Patients 3 months of age or older Diagnosis of acute bronchitis/ bronchiolitis 	 Hospice/Palliative care Competing diagnosis (ex. otitis media) on or within three days after the episode date Underlying comorbid conditions (refer to tip sheet) Death in the measurement year
Appropriate Testing for Pharyngitis (CWP)	 Pharyngitis diagnosis Antibiotic therapy prescribed Age of 3 years or older at the time of diagnosis 	 Hospice/palliative care Any visit that results in an inpatient stay Underlying comorbid conditions Competing diagnosis Patients on antibiotic therapy within 30 days of diagnosis Patients with more than one eligible episode in a 31-day period.
Avoidance of Imaging Studies Within 28 Days of Uncomplicated Low Back Pain (LBP)	18-75 years of age with diagnosis of uncomplicated low back pain	 Comorbid conditions Competing diagnosis Palliative care, in hospice, or using hospice
Appropriate Treatment for Upper Respiratory Infection (URI)	 Upper respiratory infection diagnosis 3 months of age or older at the time of diagnosis 	 Any visits resulting in an inpatient stay Hospice/palliative care Competing diagnosis (ex. Otitis media) on or within three days after the episode date Underlying comorbid conditions
