# **Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits (WCV)**

By working together, we can improve health outcomes for your patients, our members. The Healthcare Effectiveness Data and Information Set (HEDIS®) helps us measure many aspects of performance. This tip sheet provides key details of the HEDIS measure for a child and adolescent well-care visit.

### What is the measure?

The measure focuses on members between the age of 3 and 21 who had at least one comprehensive well-care visit with a primary care practitioner (PCP) or an obstetrician/gynecologist (OB/GYN) during the measurement year.

## **How To Improve Your Quality Score**

- Code visits appropriately.
- At new patient visit and every future visit, schedule the next appointment.
- Provide the recommended vaccine schedule, if appropriate.

#### Note:

Compliance is achieved with one or more reported comprehensive well-care visits with a PCP or OB/GYN during the measurement year.
